# One-Minute Madness

Estimated play time: Approximately 15 minutes  
Number of players: Unlimited  
Supplies needed: Scoring board/pad; noisemakers  
Suitable for visually impaired players

## Overview:

One question. One minute. Multiple answers. In **One-Minute Madness**, a question is asked that has multiple answers (usually anywhere from 5 to 100+). The goal is to see how many correct answers your players can come up with in one minute.

This St. Patrick's Day week, we're celebrating Ireland, which is just one of eight countries that end with the letters LAND or LANDS. But we've extended this challenge even further and are asking you to come up with as many geographic locations that end with -LAND or LANDS as you can in one minute. No fictional locations (such as Never-Never Land) are acceptable; neither are names, words, or descriptions that are not actual places (such as hinterlands; no man's land; fatherland; Judy Garland; etc.). The only correct answers are real places that can be found on a map – countries, cities, states, provinces, regions, landmarks, etc.

*Note: This particular game might work better if players are given two minutes to come up with as many answers as possible.*

## Instructions:

This game can be played several ways:

- Teams of players write down as many answers as they can in one minute, each team getting one point per correct answer;
- Individual players write down as many answers as they can in one minute, scoring as above; or
- All players just shout out answers in a free-for-all style with no scoring.
