Two-Minute Madness

Estimated play time: Approximately 15 minutes

Number of players: Unlimited

Supplies needed: Scoring board/pad; noisemakers

Suitable for visually impaired players

Overview:

One question. One minute. Multiple answers. In One-Minute Madness, a question is asked that has multiple answers (usually anywhere from 5 to 100+). The goal is to see how many correct answers your players can come up with in one minute.

For this particular game, however, we're giving you a whole extra minute! How many FAMOUS PEOPLE (living or dead; real or fictional) WITH DOUBLE INITIALS (*Arthur Ashe* or *Sylvester Stallone*, for example) can you name in two minutes?

Instructions:

This game can be played several ways:

- Teams of players write down as many answers as they can in one minute, each team getting one point per correct answer;
- Individual players write down as many answers as they can in one minute, scoring as above; or
- All players just shout out answers in a free-for-all style with no scoring.
