Qu Plus

Estimated play time: Approximately 15 minutes

Number of players: Unlimited

Supplies needed: Scoring board/pad; noisemakers

Suitable for visually impaired players.

Overview:

In this game, each question has two definitions. Both answers contain the same letters in the same order; but the second answer has an additional “Qu” placed somewhere in the word. For example:

Q: Noah’s vessel/A sub-atomic particle.

A: Ark/Quark

Instructions:

1. This game can be played by individuals or in teams.
2. Read the first pair of definitions. Discussion is permitted among teammates. Prior to the start of the game, a method to signal when a team is ready to answer must be determined. Ringing bells and New Year’s blowers are just two inexpensive noisemakers. Raised hands work, but the host must be vigilant to watch for whose hand went up first. The host always has the final say in any disputes.
3. After a player/team is recognized as the first to signal, they may give an answer. If the first answer is incorrect, the other teams may ‘buzz’ in and answer.
4. Scoring: Give 10 points for each correct answer.

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INSTRUCTIONS: In this game, each question has two definitions. Both answers contain the same letters in the same order; but the second answer has an additional “Qu” placed somewhere in the word.

2. To feel unwell/Often-hunted bird.
3. That thing/To resign from a job.
4. Not hard at all/A bit nauseated.
5. Remnants of a fire/To forcefully stop.
6. Museum holding/Two pints.
7. To irritate/An oddity.
8. Sick/The shaft of a feather.
9. Gifts to the poor/Uneasiness about one’s choices.
10. Member of the US Navy Special Forces/A high pitched sound or noise.
11. Forlorn/An army group organized for a particular task.
12. Window frame/Indoor racquet sport.
13. Popular diner dessert/A feeling of resentment.
14. To father an offspring/An attendant to a knight.
15. Prophet who led the Israelites out of Egypt /Islamic temples
