Estimated play time: Approximately 15 minutes

Number of players: Unlimited

Supplies needed: Scoring board/pad; noisemakers

Overview:

Overview: In this game, we provide twelve letters and twelve parts of words. The goal is to put one letter together with one word part to come up with the name of a well known **COMPANY OR PRODUCT**. For example:

 + **BY's** = **ARBY'S**

COTTON +  = **COTTONELLE**

Several things to note:

- The name of the letter is key, not the sound the letter produces. For example, if the clue is the letter B, the sound we're looking for is "bee" – not the "buh" sound made by that letter.
- Either the letter or the word part can come first (as shown in the examples above). Each picture and word part will be used only once.
- And finally: The pronunciation and/or spelling may not always be exact, but the answer will be easily discernible.

Instructions:

Print out (in the best quality printing available to you) the following pages and pass them out to each player. If you want to save on the color printing, two players can share one document. If you have the technology, you could project the images on a screen instead.
