# From C to C

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Estimated play time: Approximately 15 minutes

Number of players: Unlimited

Supplies needed: Scoring board/pad; noisemakers

Suitable for visually impaired players.

## Overview:

All the answers in this definition game are words or short phrases that begin and end with the letter C. *(And just a warning: this quiz is a little more challenging than usual!)*

## Instructions:

1. This game can be played by individuals or in teams.
2. Read the first definition. Discussion is permitted among teammates. Prior to the start of the game, a method to signal when a team is ready to answer must be determined. Ringing bells and New Year's blowers are just two inexpensive noisemakers. Raised hands work, but the host must be vigilant to watch for whose hand went up first. The host always has the final say in any disputes.
3. After a player/team is recognized as the first to signal, they may give an answer. If the first answer is incorrect, the other teams may "buzz" in and answer.
4. Scoring: Give 10 points for each correct answer.

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## QUESTIONS

2. A person whose job is to review a book or movie.
3. Term for a cancer-causing agent.
4. A person who tells jokes (often standing up).
5. Type of surgery that improves a patient's looks.
6. A persistent or recurring illness, such as asthma.
7. A place to get medical treatment, sometimes for free.
8. A high-quality French brandy.
9. Spasmodic pains in the abdomen that are common in young infants and often lead to extended periods of crying and irritability.
10. Of or pertaining to the universe.
11. Timeless, traditional, and/or a model of high quality.
12. Disastrous; calamitous; utterly ruinous.
13. Appearing to be in a daze, stupor, or unresponsive state.
14. Disorganized; hectic; frenzied.
15. Having an appealing or compelling charm that often inspires devotion in others.
16. Exciting or thrilling, particularly in relation to the ending of a scene.
