Number of players: Unlimited


Supplies needed: The page(s) with the rebuses should be either projected on a screen or printed with a copy distributed to each player.

This rebus is translated as *EYE + LOVE (Glove minus the G) + U* — or, *I love you*.








If you sound out the words *DIE + NOSE + OAR*, you get the word *Dinosaur*.








Print (in the best quality printing available to you – color is best, but black and white should work, too) the following pages and pass them out to each player. If you want to save on the color printing, two players can share one document.
