Compound Images

Estimated play time: Approximately 15 minutes

Number of players: Unlimited

Supplies needed: Scoring board/pad; noisemakers

Overview:

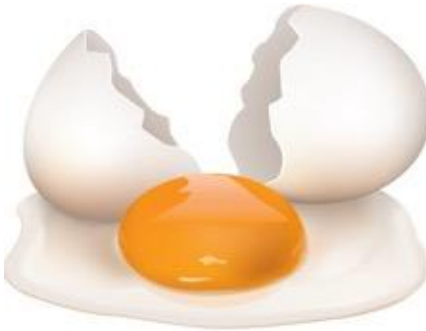
In this game we provide eighteen images. The goal is to put two images together to come up with nine words, compound words, or two-word phrases.

While the given words or phrases may not always be spelled correctly in the clues, the resulting answers will always be pronounced correctly. For example, the image of the letter P and the image of a tin can would yield the word *pecan* (P + can). Or the image of Jim Carrey and the image of a jungle would yield the phrase *jungle gym* (jungle + Jim). A third example might be the image of a tiger's tail and the image of a fence gate, which would yield the compound word *tailgate*.

In this challenge, each image will be used only once.

Instructions:

Print (in the best quality printing available to you – color is best, but black and white should work, too) the following two pages and pass them out to each player. If you want to save on the color printing, two players can share one document. If you have the technology, you could also project the images on a screen.
