Estimated play time: Approximately 15 minutes

Number of players: Unlimited

Supplies needed: Scoring board/pad; noisemakers

Fill in the blank space to complete **FIVE** words, names, phrases, idioms, or sayings that begin with or end with the given clue. For example, take the clue: SHIRT Some possible correct answers include: Flannel shirt, Hawaiian shirt, Lose one's shirt, Polo shirt, Stuffed shirt, Sweatshirt, T-shirt, Undershirt, etc. Some incorrect answers would be: Shirtsleeves, Shirtwaist, Shirttail, etc. These answers are incorrect because a correct answer has to **come before** the word *SHIRT*. Another example of an incorrect answer would be *Orange shirt*. That is an incorrect answer because, while a person could have an orange shirt, it is NOT a common name, phrase, idiom,

Here's another example: CITY . Some possible correct answers are: Citywide, City of Brotherly Love, City limit, City Hall, City Council, etc.

Some incorrect answers would be: Capacity, Electricity, Felicity, etc. These answers are incorrect for two reasons: 1) While they do end with the letters C-I-T-Y, they don't end with the word CITY; and 2) Since the word CITY precedes the blank space in the clue, a correct answer has to **come after** the word CITY.

Note: This is a better brain workout if you put a one-minute timer on the individual/team answering the question.

Instructions:

- 1. This game can be played by individuals or in teams.
- 2. Select one team to begin, read the clue -i.e., (Blank) SHIRT or CITY (Blank) and start the one-minute timer.
- 3. The player/team must provide **FIVE** correct answers. (Teams can work together.) If five correct answers are not given, the other team(s) may "buzz" in and answer.
- 4. Scoring: Give 50 points to the person/team that successfully comes up with five correct answers.
