Estimated play time: Approximately 15 minutes

Number of players: Unlimited

Supplies needed: Scoring board/pad; noisemakers

Overview:

Hangman is an English word game that most historians believe was developed during the Victorian era (1837 - 1901). Today, most English-speaking kids learn how to play **Hangman** around the same time they become proficient in spelling.
