Estimated play time: Approximately 15 minutes

Number of players: Unlimited

Supplies needed: Scoring board/pad; noisemakers

Overview:

Overview: In this game, we provide twelve pictures and twelve parts of words. The goal is to create words by putting one picture together with one word part. For example:



The word part *CRES*, plus the picture of the *CENT*, make the word *CRESCENT*. It is important to note that the spelling of each answer word will be exact, but in some instances the resulting pronunciation may need to be modified. Also, either the picture or the word part can come first.

Each picture and word part will be used only once.

Instructions:

Print out (in the best quality printing available to you – color is best, but black and white should work, too) the following pages and pass them out to each player. If you want to save on the color printing, two players can share one document. If you have the technology, you could also project the images on a screen.



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
INSTRUCTIONS: Put one picture together with one word part to come up with a new word. Each picture and word part will be used only once.
