Group Therapy (F)

Estimated play time: Approximately 15 minutes
Number of players: Unlimited
Supplies needed: Scoring board/pad; noisemakers
Suitable for visually impaired players.

Overview:

In this game, each question has several answers. The goal is to come up with the number of correct answers required in the question. For example: *Can you name five shades of the color red?* Possible answers could be: *Scarlet, Maroon, Rose, Crimson, Garnet.*

For this version (which we will do weekly-ish until we run through the whole alphabet), all your answers must start with the letter called for in the game. This week, that letter is **F**.

Instructions:

1. This game can be played by individuals or in teams.
2. Read the first question. Discussion is permitted among teammates. Prior to the start of the game, a method to signal when a player/team is ready to answer must be determined. Ringing bells and New Year's blowers are just two inexpensive noisemakers. Raised hands work, but the host must be vigilant to watch for whose hand went up first. The host always has the final say in any disputes.
3. After a player/team is recognized as the first to signal, they may give an answer. If the first answer is incorrect, the others may 'buzz' in and answer.
4. Keep score (10 points for each answer) after each question is answered correctly. Play until all questions have been asked and answered.

7. Name one of the two US presidents whose last names begin with the letter F.
8. These four words are most of the vocabulary of the giant in "Jack and the Beanstalk."
9. Can you name five animals (of any type) that begin with the letter F?
10. How many three-letter words that begin with F can you come up with?
11. Name at least two of the four poker hands that start with the letter F.
12. Name two car makes and/or models that start with F.
13. How many of the following famous people, whose last names all begin with F, can you identify?
 - a. He wrote *The Great Gatsby* and *Tender is the Night*.
 - b. She starred in *Rosemary's Baby* in 1968, the same year she was divorced from her first husband, Frank Sinatra.
 - c. She was a frequent panelist on the game show *Match Game* in the 1970s, and is the author of *Fried Green Tomatoes at the Whistle Stop Café*.
 - d. She played Gidget and the Flying Nun on television and Norma Rae in the movies.
 - e. This British author wrote *Chitty Chitty Bang Bang*, as well as the James Bond series of spy novels.
 - f. At the age of 86, this famous poet read his well-known poem "The Gift Outright" at the inauguration of President John F. Kennedy.
 - g. Her most famous role was as *Star Wars'* Princess Leia.
