# Anagrams in 8's & 4's

---

Estimated play time: Approximately 15 minutes  
Number of players: Unlimited  
Supplies needed: Scoring board/pad; noisemakers  
May be suitable for visually impaired players.

Homework games usually differ from our typical game formats in that they are meant for individual play and will often require pencil and paper to solve. However, with a little adaptation, you can usually use them for group play as well. For homework games, we recommend that you hand out the game page (but not the answers) for your players to take home. Perhaps you can post the answers on a bulletin board or in the elevator a couple of days later.

## Overview:

In this game, you are provided with a set of eight letters. Your job is to use the letters to make one eight-letter word (or name) and two four-letter words for each set.

For example, given the letters *RSPDTAAE*, you could make the eight-letter word *ADAPTERS* and the four-letter words *DARE* and *PAST*.

The four-letter words must not form a part of the eight-letter words. For instance, the words *HARD* and *WARE* cannot be used if the eight-letter word is *HARDWARE*.
