# Complete the Words

---

Estimated play time: Approximately 15 minutes  
Number of players: Unlimited  
Supplies needed: Scoring board/pad; noisemakers  
Suitable for visually impaired players.

## Overview:

Homework games usually differ from our typical game formats in that they are meant for individual play and will often require pencil and paper to solve. However, with a little adaptation, you can usually use them for group play as well. For homework games, we recommend that you hand out the game page (but not the answers) for your players to take home. Perhaps you can post the answers on a bulletin board or in the elevator a couple of days later.

## Instructions:

Place a letter of the alphabet in each of the blank spaces in the grid to make a word of five letters or more (reading across the row). Each of the 26 letters of the alphabet will be used only once. While not all letters in the rows will be used, each correct answer will use at least one space on the right and one space on the left of the inserted letter. **No hyphenated words, plurals, foreign words, or proper nouns are used to solve this game; and your answer should be the longest word possible in each row.**
