Letter Pairs

Estimated play time: Approximately 15 minutes
Number of players: Unlimited
Supplies needed: Scoring board/pad; noisemakers

Overview:

Homework games usually differ from our typical game formats in that they are meant for individual play and will often require pencil and paper to solve. However, with a little adaptation, you can usually use them for group play as well. For homework games, we recommend that you hand out the game page (but not the answers) for your players to take home. Perhaps you can post the answers on a bulletin board or in the elevator a couple of days later.

Instructions:

The list on the left shows the first two letters of 10 six-letter words. To come up with the last four letters of each word, you need to add two of the 20 two-letter pairs found on the right side of the page. Each two-letter pair will be used only once.
