Syllability

Estimated play time: Approximately 15 minutes

Number of players: Unlimited

Supplies needed: Scoring board/pad; noisemakers

Overview:

This game contains a grid of syllables and a list of questions. Each question is answered by a word made up only of syllables available in the grid. (The number in parentheses indicates the number of syllables in the word.) Once you've used a syllable, cross it out. No syllable can be used more than once, unless it is listed in the grid more than once. All syllables must be used to complete the game.

Instructions:

1. Read the first definition.
2. Use the grid of syllables to help you figure out the correct answer.
3. Once you've determined the answer, cross out the syllables you've used.
4. Proceed to the next definition, making sure you cross out the syllables you've used.
5. The game is complete when you have used all the syllables to create the correct answers.
