Things ...

Estimated play time: Approximately 15 minutes

Number of players: Unlimited

Supplies needed: Scoring board/pad; noisemakers

Maybe be suitable for visually impaired players (with some assistance).

Overview:

Homework games usually differ from our typical game formats in that they are meant for individual play and will often require pencil and paper to solve. However, with a little adaptation, you can usually use them for group play as well. For homework games, we recommend that you hand out the game page (but not the answers) for your players to take home. Perhaps you can post the answers on a bulletin board or in the elevator a couple of days later.

Instructions:

THINGS ... is a word search puzzle. Hidden in the following grid are words related to a particular theme. This week's theme is **THINGS ... THAT ARE FOUND IN THE KITCHEN**. The first letter of each of the eight hidden words is given below the grid as a clue. The subsequent letters of each word **MUST** touch each other in any direction (right, left, over, under, or diagonally). The hidden words **DO NOT** overlap; each letter will be used only once and in only one word; and all the letters in the grid will be used.
