Overview:

Each picture on the next page represents one half of a compound word. For example, if you combine *key* and *hole*, you get *keyhole*. How many of the 28 possible compound words can you find?

(Note: All pictures are used, and some are used more than once.)

Instructions:

Print (in the best quality printing available to you – color is best, but black and white should work, too) the first two pages and pass them out to each player. If you want to save on the color printing, two players can share one document. If you have the technology, you could also project the images on a screen.
