Weekly Trivia Quiz 2

Estimated play time: Approximately 20 minutes

Number of players: Unlimited

Supplies needed: Scoring board/pad; noisemakers

Suitable for visually impaired players.

Overview:

You already know how to play trivia quizzes. Here are a few additional ideas to consider if you want a more, or less, competitive game.

Instructions

1. Create a tournament format in which permanent teams compete in playoffs and a final champion team is crowned.
2. Collect a small amount of money from each player (for example, 50 cents or a dollar) and put it into a kitty. The winning team splits the kitty.
3. Buy some lottery tickets to use as prizes for the winners (and runners up).
4. To create a less competitive game, just give one point for every question answered.

SEXIEST MEN ALIVE

- 10 Pts He was *People* magazine's first "Sexiest Man Alive" in 1985, after he starred in the Mad Max film series, *The Year of Living Dangerously*, and *The Bounty*.
- 20 Pts When he received his first "Sexiest Man" award (1997), he was playing a doctor on TV. For his second, he had just directed and starred in the 2005 movie *Good Night, and Good Luck*.
- 30 Pts At 27, he was *People*'s youngest "Sexiest Man" and one of only three non-actors to be awarded the title. At the time (1988) he was a law student at New York University.
- 40 Pts In 1996, this actor was the first African American "Sexiest Man." He's known for his portrayals of real-life characters, including Malcolm X in 1992.
- 50 Pts In 1989, this actor was the first (and only) Scottish winner. He was also the oldest, at age 59.

- 20 Pts This modern slang term may sound like a rodent, but it actually refers to teens who hang out at shopping centers.
- 30 Pts If the slang term for a Canadian \$1 coin is “loonie,” what is the slang term for the Canadian \$2 coin?
- 40 Pts What would you have if an American gave you “two bits”?
- 50 Pts Before it acquired its musical meaning in Chicago around 1915, this word was slang for “pep” or “energy.”
