# Prime Time Rhyme

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Estimated play time: Approximately 15 minutes  
Number of players: Unlimited  
Supplies needed: Scoring board/pad; noisemakers  
Suitable for visually impaired players.

## Overview:

There are three answers to each question, and they all rhyme.

## Instructions:

1. This game can be played by individuals or in teams.
2. Read the first three definitions. Discussion is permitted among teammates. Prior to the start of the game, a method to signal when a team is ready to answer must be determined. Ringing bells and New Year's blowers are just two inexpensive noisemakers. Raised hands work, but the host must be vigilant to watch for whose hand went up first. The host always has the final say in any disputes.
3. After a player/team is recognized as the first to signal, they may give an answer. If the first answer is incorrect, the other teams may 'buzz' in and answer.
4. Scoring: Give 10 points for each correct answer.

1. A python or cobra; A unit of snow; Not asleep
2. To lament the loss of a loved one; Iconic summer vegetable; To feel or express contempt
3. Indelible skin decoration; Tall grass and favorite food of the panda; Sound of a sneeze
4. Not loose; Flying brothers; Well mannered
5. Early 60's TV western starring Clint Eastwood; An overwhelming majority of votes for a single winning candidate; Teeth-protecting compound
6. To glide on ice;  $2^3$  (two cubed); You're "in good hands" with this insurance company
7. Lack of proper care or attention; To choose or single out; To cut up a specimen in order to study its parts
8. Stone or boulder; Blackboard marker; Pedestrian-safe pathway
9. Outdoor meals; Asian "cutlery;" Mythical bird that periodically rises from the ashes
10. Direction in which the sun sets; A temporary visitor; Clinically sad or despondent
11. Where an electric plug goes; Vehicle that is propelled by jet fuel and can fly in the vacuum of space; Thief who targets his victim's clothing or wallet
12. To breathe out; Extortion; Budweiser horse breed
