## Overview

Rebuses have been around for hundreds of years. They are visual games that use pictures to represent words or parts of words in a name or phrase or sentence. For example:


This rebus is translated as EYE + LOVE (Glove minus the G) $+\mathrm{U}=$ I love you.

Note: In this particular game, all of the rebus puzzles are titles of books, movies, plays, magazines or television shows.
