Estimated play time: Approximately 15 minutes

Number of players: Unlimited

Supplies needed: Scoring board/pad; noisemakers

Overview:

Overview: In this game, we give you twelve pictures and twelve letters. The goal is to put one picture with one letter to come up with a new word. Note: You must pronounce the **NAME** of the letter. For example:



E

The picture of a *batter*, plus the letter *E*, makes the word *Battery*. It is important to note that:

- In some instances the spelling will not be exact, but the pronunciation will always be correct;
- The letter can occur either before or after the picture.
- Each letter and picture will be used only once.

Instructions:

Print out (in the best quality printing available to you – color is best, but black and white should work, too) the following pages and pass them out to each player. If you want to save on the color printing, two players can share one document. If you have the technology, you could also project the images on a screen.
