Estimated play time: Approximately 15 minutes

Supplies needed: Scoring board/pad; noisemakers

Overview:

Overview: In this game, we provide twelve pictures and twelve parts of words. The goal is to put one picture together with one word part to come up with the name of a FOOD. For example:



olate

The picture of the *chalk*, plus the word part *olate* makes the word *chocolate*. It is important to note that in some instances the spelling may not be exact, but the pronunciation will always be correct. Also, either the picture or the word part can come first.

Instructions:

Print out (in the best quality printing available to you – color is best, but black and white should work, too) the following pages and pass them out to each player. If you want to save on the color printing, two players can share one document. If you have the technology, you could also project the images on a screen.
